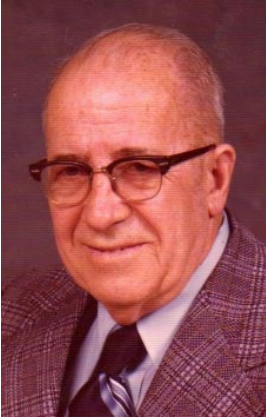


CLARENCE ARTHUR GERFERS, SR.
